#### STARSKATE PROGRAMS

StarSkate programs begin September 12, 2011, 2010 and end May 17, 2012, 2011. The number of weeks will vary for each program day. Programs are priced according to number of skating days, number of minutes per class, and adjusted for all exception days (holidays, competitions, tournaments, etc.) when there is no skating.

For Spring the following changes in time are scheduled:

**NOTE:** All session fees cover ice time, group coaching (where applicable), and club administration. They do NOT cover Skate Canada Fees and Insurance. There is a one time charge per year for these fees of \$32.00. There is also a \$40 Skater Development Fee for StarSkaters.

**NOTE:** *\*\*If registering for more than one Starskate session per skater, a discount of \$142 will be applied for each additional session per skater up to Oct 31<sup>st</sup>, 2011.*

## Eligibility Requirements

### LEARN-TO-SKATE PROGRAMS

*Hockey-style CSA-approved helmets are mandatory for all Learn-to-Skate programs.*

#### CanSkate for PreSchool

A 30 minute learn to skate program for 3 and 4 year olds offering an introduction to the basics of skating, through toys and games, led by one of our Skate Canada certified coaches.

#### CanSkate

A learn to skate program designed for children 5 years and up. Skaters progress through 7 different levels of skating skills. The program consists of a 15 minute warm-up followed by a 30 minute group lesson led by one of our Skate Canada certified coaches.

#### CanSkate for Adults/Teens

A learn to skate program to teach adults of all ages and teens (15 yrs +) the basic skills of skating or to improve on the old ones. The program consists of a 10 minute warm-up followed by a 40 minute group lesson from one of our Skate Canada Certified coaches. A CSA helmet is mandatory for participants at Stage 5 or lower.

#### CanSkate for Hockey / Ringette (formerly Power Skating)

Offering a 60 minute lesson on our canskate session for children 5 years and up designed to improve Hockey and Ringette players skating skills. Focus is on balance speed, power, agility, speed and endurance co-ordination.

Skaters entering this program must be able to skate forward, backwards and stop. Full hockey equipment is optional. **No Sticks.**

### STARSKATE PROGRAMS

*All skaters must skate at the level for which they qualify; any exceptions to this require Board approval. All skaters must have a private coach.*

#### Junior

Must have passed CanSkate Badge 6.

#### Intermediate

Must have passed two of the following complete tests: Preliminary Freeskate, Preliminary Skills, Preliminary Dances; **OR** be at least 14 years of age and have passed one of the above complete tests.

#### HIGH Intermediate

Skaters **MUST** have passed BOTH the complete Preliminary Freeskate test AND Junior Bronze Skills.

#### Senior

Must have passed two of the following complete tests: Junior Bronze Freeskate, Senior Bronze Skills, Senior Bronze Dances; **OR** be at least 16 years of age and have passed one of the above complete tests.
