## **ENTRY FORMS/DEADLINES**

All entries **must be received by Friday, January 20, 2012 at 4:00 pm.** Please submit all entries from your club **TOGETHER, WITH ONE CLUB CHEQUE.** Changes/corrections to entries **after February 27** will be subject to a \$25 administrative fee. (We will aim for a schedule and groups being posted by Feb. 22, giving coaches/skaters 5 days to check for errors or omissions).

## **TECHNICAL INFORMATION**

For all event requirements please refer to the Skate Canada Northern Ontario 2011-2012 Generic Technical Package as posted on the SCNO website [www.scno.net](http://www.scno.net) and the Skate Canada technical handbook. All events **MUST** follow the Well Balanced Program criteria.

There will be separate groups for men and women in the free skate and competitive events.

Male and female skaters will compete against each other in the interpretive events, elements, and spins if only one man is entered in an event; if there are two men or more, there will be a "men's" event.

Groups will be divided by age first then, where possible, skaters from the same club will be placed in different groups.

Competitors shall have met the test requirements by the closing date of the competition. Competitors may skate up one category and may enter the STARSkate OR Competitive singles events – **NOT BOTH.**

STARSkate events up to Preliminary will be judged using the OBO one-by-one system. Competitive events and Starskate Junior Bronze level and higher will be judged using the CPC system.

## **COMPETITIVE EVENTS**

Singles Short and Free Skate will be skated as separate categories. Short program requirements to be skated are those for NEXT SEASON (2012-13) as listed on the Skate Canada Website.

## **TEAM EVENTS**



Four skaters make up a team. In the event that a club does not have four skaters in an event, skaters from different clubs may combine on one team provided that each skater competes for **ONLY** one team in the same event. All four skaters on a team must have passed no higher than the free style test listed for that level of competition, but may have a lower test. Each skater on the team is required to complete one of the elements listed below. **Note: we will offer teams and jumps only if time allows; a full refund will be provided if the event is cancelled.**

**NO RE-SKATES ALLOWED THIS SEASON. COMPETITIVE SKATERS MAY ENTER PROVIDED THEY ADHERE TO THE REQUIREMENTS.**

Each element will be given a mark and all five marks will be totaled giving the final score in order to give the team their final (ordinal) placement.

### **INTRODUCTORY TEAM ELEMENTS**

**TEST REQUIREMENTS: May not have passed any part of a preliminary free skate test,**

**SPECIFICATIONS FOR EVENT:**

1. Waltz Jump
2. Toe Loop
3. Salchow
4. Forward traditional spiral (choice of edge) – no variation

### **PRE-PRELIMINARY TEAM ELEMENTS**

*TEST REQUIREMENTS:* Must not have passed the complete Preliminary Free Skate Test.

*SPECIFICATIONS FOR EVENT:*

1. Loop Jump
2. Flip Jump
3. Waltz Jump Toe Loop Combination
4. Forward traditional spiral outside edge – no variation

### **PRELIMINARY TEAM ELEMENTS**

*TEST REQUIREMENTS:* May have passed the Preliminary Free Skate test but no higher complete Free Skate test.

*SPECIFICATIONS FOR EVENT:*

1. Lutz Jump
2. Axel Jump
3. Loop Loop Combination
4. Inside Ina Bauer or Inside Spread Eagle

### **JUNIOR BRONZE TEAM ELEMENTS**

*TEST REQUIREMENTS:* May have passed the Junior Bronze Free Skate test but no higher complete Free Skate test.

*SPECIFICATIONS FOR EVENT:*

1. Axel Jump
2. Double Salchow Jump **OR** Double Toe Loop Jump **OR** Double Loop Jump
3. Jump Combination with 2 singles or 1 double and 1 single
4. Step Sequence demonstrating minimum 3 different turns and steps (any shape; ½ ice only)

### **SENIOR BRONZE TEAM ELEMENTS**

*TEST REQUIREMENTS:* May have passed the Senior Bronze Free Skate test or Juvenile Competitive test but no higher complete Free Skate test.

*SPECIFICATIONS FOR EVENT:*

1. Axel Jump
2. Double Salchow Jump **OR** Double Toe Loop Jump **OR** Double Loop Jump
3. Jump Combination with 1 single and 1 double or 2 doubles, the first jump must be the double
4. Circular Step Sequence demonstrating minimum 3 different turns and steps (1/2 ice surface)

## **PLANNED PROGRAM CONTENT**

A Planned Program Content Sheet must be sent with entry forms for competitive events and for Starskate Junior Bronze and higher. If the program changes, you can hand in your new PPC when you register at the event but this **MUST BE DONE AT LEAST 2 HOURS BEFORE YOUR SCHEDULED EVENT START TIME**. Forms are available on the SCNO website.

## **MUSIC**

Music must be registered at least one hour prior to the event. Each competitor must hand in two copies of their music either on CD (CD-R format) or on cassette or any combination thereof. All music should be clearly marked with the competitor's name, the event and indicate which one is the master and which is the copy.

## **AWARDS**

All events are finals. There will be **NO** medals awarded in the Introductory FREESKATE event. Skaters will receive a ribbon based on their level of achievement (Bronze, Silver or Gold in accordance with the Skate Canada Standards)

along with a written feedback form. For all other events, 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> place standings will receive medals during a medal ceremony at the beginning of each flood. The Deegan's Memorial Trophy will be awarded to the club scoring the highest total points at the end of the competition. The antique skate is no longer given out but an engraved plaque is presented.

### **MISCELLANEOUS**

Competitors **MUST** arrive at Memorial Gardens at least one hour prior to their scheduled event start time.  
(the schedule MAY run early)

All coaches must wear their current Coaches Identification at all times.

Proof of Test is required for all events.

Incomplete forms which result in a follow up telephone call or email may result in disqualification from an event. There will be a \$35 administration fee on any NSF cheques. Competitors with monies owing will not be permitted to skate until all outstanding monies have been paid.

Event confirmations and schedules will NOT be mailed or emailed. All groups and schedule information will be posted on the North Bay Figure Skating Club and Skate Canada Northern Ontario websites. It is the responsibility of the coaches, skaters and parents to ensure that their skater(s) is registered in the proper events. (We will aim for a schedule and groups being posted by Feb. 22, giving coaches/skaters 5 days to check for errors or omissions)

### **REFUND POLICY**

Entry fees shall be refunded **ONLY** if the event is not held. No refunds or withdrawals will be accepted after the closing date without a medical certificate (for injuries that prohibit the skater from performing **ONLY**) or at the discretion of the organizing committee when the request is submitted in writing).

### **ON SITE TESTING**

Skaters may apply to be tested as they perform their programs. You must compete in the event you wish to be tested. A \$10 non-refundable administration fee applies plus the Skate Canada test fee. Please complete the test application in full. Skate Canada deadlines for test requests and pulls will be strictly enforced.

## **ADMISSION**

Competitors will receive accreditation tags. Coaches please bring your Coaches ID. There will be no chaperone passes provided.

Admission fees are:

- Full event ticket is \$10
- Adults \$5 per day
- Students/Seniors \$4
- Children under 12 will be admitted free when accompanied by an adult.
