Test Requirements: Test and age requirements are as of Jan. 1, 2012.

Please note that clubs must submit a signed registration sheet and publicity waiver for all skaters, along with print copies of the complete Island Skate Registration Electronic Forms, and Good Luck messages with their cheque.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Music:

Two labeled CDs or cassette tapes or one CD and one cassette must be registered at the Music Registration Desk at least one hour prior to the event and may be picked up following the posting of each event's results. Please note that CD's may not be in MP3 format.

Ice Surface:

The Recreation Centre has an ice surface measuring 185 X 85 feet.

Snack Bar:

There is an excellent food booth upstairs in the auditorium of the rec. centre, with coffee guaranteed to be ready and waiting in the morning. There will also be a snack bar in the lower lobby.

Admissions:

Competitors, Coaches and Officials will receive accreditation at the registration desk.

General Admission will be \$4.00 per adult, \$2.00 children 4-12 if accompanied by an adult, children under 4 are free. Skate Canada Rule 7000B, 1.11 shall apply.

Scheduling of Events: Coaches please note and tell parents.

The Committee makes every effort to have skaters compete in all their events on the same day. Normally this means **Canskate and Introductory on Saturday and Pre-preliminary and higher on Sunday**. Interpretive events may be scheduled on **Friday**. Please remind skaters to arrive and be ready to skate at least one hour prior to their scheduled event.

Parent Information Letter

The CanSkate Element Event is a pilot initiative developed by Skate Canada in support of the organization's on-going implementation of the *Long Term Athlete Development Model*. The event has been formatted to recognize the philosophies of the *Learn to Skate* stage which aims to provide skaters with the opportunity to showcase their skills in a fun and interactive environment. The focus of the event is on individual skill improvement and therefore performances are not ranked. Instead of the traditional podium presentations for first, second and third, all skaters will receive a certificate indicating their overall performance level award (Gold, Silver or Bronze). The award level will be based on the assessment of four individual elements. Each element is evaluated using three predetermined performance standards. Your skater will receive a full overview of their performance on the scoring standards chart which will be provided along with their award certificate.

Schedule

Each group will be on the ice for approximately 30 minutes. Skaters should arrive at the arena approximately 1 hour prior to their warm-up time. Overall performance award certificates will be presented approximately 30 minutes following the completion of their event group and you will be given that information at the registration desk at the event.

TEAM ELEMENT EVENTS

Eligibility is by test level and is the same as listed for Free Skating Events. Each team will consist of four (4) skaters. Teams may consist of four female skaters, four male skaters, or any combination thereof. All four skaters on a team must have passed no higher than the free style test listed for that level of competition, but may have a lower test. Teams may have members from different home clubs. Substitution(s) of a team member(s) may be made after the closing date of entries for medical reasons only. A skater may participate in only one team event at each level.

Each team member will execute one of four elements listed for their event. Each element will be given a mark and all four marks will be totaled giving the final score in order to give the team their final (ordinal) placement.

The Compulsory Team Events will not be skated to music. Elements are performed in isolation.

NO reskates permitted.

INTRODUCTORY TEAM ELEMENTS

TEST REQUIREMENTS: **May not have passed any part of a preliminary free skate test,**

SPECIFICATIONS FOR EVENT:

1. Waltz Jump
2. Toe Loop
3. Salchow
4. Forward traditional spiral (choice of edge) – no variation

PRE-PRELIMINARY TEAM ELEMENTS

TEST REQUIREMENTS: Must not have passed the complete Preliminary Free Skate Test.

SPECIFICATIONS FOR EVENT:

1. Loop Jump
2. Flip Jump
3. Waltz Jump Toe Loop Combination
4. Forward traditional spiral outside edge – no variation

PRELIMINARY TEAM ELEMENTS

TEST REQUIREMENTS: May have passed the Preliminary Free Skate test but no higher complete Free Skate test.

SPECIFICATIONS FOR EVENT:

1. Lutz Jump
2. Axel Jump
3. Loop Loop Combination
4. Inside Ina Bauer or Inside Spread Eagle

JUNIOR BRONZE TEAM ELEMENTS

TEST REQUIREMENTS: May have passed the Junior Bronze Free Skate test but no higher complete Free Skate test.

SPECIFICATIONS FOR EVENT:

1. Axel Jump
2. Double Salchow Jump **OR** Double Toe Loop Jump **OR** Double Loop Jump
3. Jump Combination with 2 singles or 1 double and 1 single
4. Step Sequence demonstrating minimum 3 different turns and steps (any shape; ½ ice only)

SENIOR BRONZE TEAM ELEMENTS

TEST REQUIREMENTS: May have passed the Senior Bronze Free Skate test or Juvenile Competitive test but no higher complete Free Skate test.

SPECIFICATIONS FOR EVENT:

1. Axel Jump
2. Double Salchow Jump **OR** Double Toe Loop Jump **OR** Double Loop Jump
3. Jump Combination with 1 single and 1 double or 2 doubles, the first jump must be the double
4. Circular Step Sequence demonstrating minimum 3 different turns and steps (1/2 ice surface)

JUNIOR SILVER TEAM ELEMENTS

TEST REQUIREMENTS: May have passed the Junior Silver Free Skate test or PreNovice Competitive test but no higher complete free skate test

SPECIFICATIONS FOR EVENT:

1. Axel or Double Axel
2. Double Loop or Double Flip
3. Jump combination with 1 single and 1 double or 2 doubles, the second jump must be the double
4. Any shape Step Sequence demonstrating minimum 3 different turns and steps (full ice surface)

SENIOR SILVER TEAM ELEMENTS

TEST REQUIREMENTS: May have passed the Senior Silver Free Skate test or Novice Competitive test but no higher complete Free Skate test

SPECIFICATIONS FOR EVENT:

1. Axel or Double Axel
2. Double Flip or Double Lutz
3. Jump Combination with 2 double jumps
4. Any Shape Step Sequence (full ice surface)

GOLD TEAM ELEMENTS

TEST REQUIREMENTS: May have passed the Gold Free Skate test or Junior Competitive test

SPECIFICATIONS FOR EVENT:

1. Double Lutz
2. Double Flip
3. Jump Combination consisting of 2 double jumps OR 1 double and 1 triple jump
4. Combined sequence of field moves and steps – any shape (full ice); 30 second maximum

Each club is to send one package that includes:

- Complete check list;
- All completed and signed skater entry and waiver forms;
- Coaches Checklist with appropriate documentation for all coaches attending competition;
- Individual Event Summary and Grand Summary Sheet;
- Complete EXCEL file on a disk (also to be sent to scmanitoulin@hotmail.com);
- One cheque covering the full amount of Entry Fees;

Clubs will be assessed a **\$25 service charge** for **incomplete, incorrect** or **late** packages.

Refunds only in the case of injury **with a medical slip**, or at the **discretion of the host committee**.
