TECHNICAL INFORMATION

For all event requirements please refer to the Skate Canada Northern Ontario 2011-2012 Generic Technical Package as posted on the SCNO website www.scno.net and the Skate Canada technical handbook. All events **MUST** follow the Well Balanced Program criteria.

Male and female skaters will compete against each other in the Interpretive events. Groups will be divided by age as much as possible. Where possible, skaters from the same club will be placed in different groups. Elements and spins events are to be skated in isolation – no retries.

Competitors shall have met the test requirements by February 1st, 2012. Competitors may skate up one category and may enter the STARSkate or Competitive singles event – NOT BOTH

Introductory to Preliminary STARSkate events and all Interpretive events will be judged using the OBO one-by-one system. Competitive events and Starskate Junior Bronze to Gold will be judged using CPC system.

COMPETITIVE EVENTS

Singles Short and Free Skate will be skated as separate categories. Short program requirements to be skated are those **for 2012-2013 SEASON** as set out in the Skate Canada rule book. Age limits now in effect for Pre-Juvenile to Junior events.

REGISTRATION

All skaters must register at the arena 2 hours before their event.

PLANNED PROGRAM CONTENT

A Planned Program Content Sheet must be handed in at least **two hours before** the event when you register at the event. Forms are available on the SCNO website.

MUSIC

Music must be registered at least **two hours prior** to the event. Each competitor must hand in two copies of their music on CDs. All music should be clearly marked with the competitor's name, the event and indicate which one is the master and which is the copy.

AWARDS

Introductory Free Skate Events will be receiving assessment certificates. Medals will be presented to the top three in all other events. Ribbons will be awarded to fourth place through eighth. The Judges will select one skater to receive the Ashley Waite Award based on a memorable performance.

ON –SITE TESTING

Skaters may apply to be tested as they perform their programs. Please submit the TEST SHEET APPLICATION and a SEPARATE CHEQUE along with appropriate test sheets / summary sheets and club permission with entry form. See test application for test fees.

MISCELLANEOUS

Competitors are advised to be at Countryside Arena one hour prior to their scheduled event time.

All coaches must wear their current Coaches Identification at all times.

We may run up to 30 minutes ahead of the scheduled time.

ENTRY FORMS / DEADLINES

All entries must be received by MARCH 1st, 2012 at 6:00 pm.
