What's New for the 2018/2019 Skating Season

Ajax Skating Club is looking forward to the 2018/2019 season. It promises to be a great season and we have some great new things happening at the club.

2018/2019 will bring some new programs to the Ajax Skating Club. For those looking towards a future in hockey or ringette we will be offering a group on Saturday mornings that will focus more on these skills. While not a separte session, skaters that wish to focus on hockey or ringette can register for the PrePower group during the regular Saturday CanSkate Session. Skaters will complete the warm up and cool down with the entire group and then during the group lessons the PrePower skaters will be in their own group. These Skaters will continue to work on the CanSkate badge program but the focus will be slanted toward hockey and ringette skills and Skaters do not require any terminology. special equipment for this (no pads/sticks etc).

Another new option coming in 2018/2019 is the Special Needs CanSkate and PreCan Skate groups on Saturday mornings. Again, this is not a separate program. Skaters will warm up and cool down with the entire group and then will break off into a smaller group for the lesson portion of the class. The Special Needs group will be staffed according to the skater's needs providing more support to our skaters with physical, intellectual and emotional exceptionalities. Skaters in this group may also have future opportunities to participate in Special Olympics programming.

CanSkate Elite will be offered on Wednesdays and Thursdays this year. Skaters that have completed CanSkate Stage 4 (or have been recommended by a coach) can register for this program. This program runs concurrently with the STARSkate Level 1-2 program and helps accellerate the skater's progression through the remainder of the CanSkate Stages. This program aslo offers skaters an introduction into the STARSkate program and figure skating in general.

We are very excited about these new options at Ajax Skating Club and hope it will allow our participants to fulfill future goals and become life long skaters.
